





19th NCARC 2024 BUSINESS MEETINGS REPORT

The NCAR Advocate Committee served as the natural business body to the NCAR Conference. The Committee, with representation from multiple chapters, was well positioned to organize the business meetings for the 19th NCARC – scheduling the meetings, drafting the agendas, and recruiting business meeting functions.

RESOLUTIONS

The NCAR Advocates requested resolutions to all I.I. NCAR chapters in January 2024 with a deadline of end of May 2024 (six months prior to the conference).

- Although many resolutions were drafted by the Advocates the final resolutions were a result of discussion with chapters at a Zoom meeting on June 15, 2024.
- Advocates were also able to discuss the resolutions with chapters at their Area Meetings
- The Virtual Chapter Resolution was added in July.
- A total of nine resolutions were presented and approved. (I= International)

BUSINESS MEETINGS

As in past regional conferences, two business meetings were scheduled.

Business Meeting #1

The first business meeting took place **virtually** two weeks prior to the conference (Saturday, September 28, 2024).

- This allowed chapters whose members were not attending the conference to participate in the discussion and decisions pertaining to the resolutions.
- The presidents of chapters without delegates attending NCARC were allowed to participate as de facto Delegates and able to vote by proxy. (If the president did not attend this virtual meeting, they did not qualify for a proxy vote.)







- The meeting was scheduled at 6 pm EDT to allow participation from five International Board members from Japan.
- We received input from the International Board on the resolutions prior to the business meetings and were shared during the meeting.
- Scheduling the meeting prior to NCARC had the additional benefit of freeing a time slot for extra programming during the conference.
- At Business Meeting #1, 50 chapters participated out of 63 in NCAR.

Business Meeting #2

The second business meeting took place in Philadelphia on October 16, 2024.

- 42 Delegates from 38 chapters were present. An additional 9 chapters voted by proxy.
- All nine resolutions were approved; four resolutions require further approval from the International Board.
- The NCAR ADVOCATE TERM REPORT (2019-2024) was presented outlining the achievements as well as the challenges ahead for the region. (See video here.)
- A fifteen minute "Good of the Order" allowed all attendees (not only Delegates) to make comments or ask questions.
